Faculty of Engineering & Technology Rules for Improvement of Grade

Persons who hold a Passing grade at the Graduate / Postgraduate level under Faculty of Engineering & Technology and who wish to appear for the same examination in the same subjects in order to improve their grade to secure higher grade shall be allowed to do so as per the provisions of the following rules:

- 1. The concession to re-appear will be available only to the holders of the Bachelors and / or Master's degree of this University, in Faculty of Engineering & Technology.
- 2. The candidate shall appear for minimum two papers of his/her choice.
- 3. The marks of the other subjects for which candidate is not appearing will be carried forward. The marks of the papers for which candidate is appearing for improvement of grade shall be added in those marks and grade shall be decided on the basis of total marks.
- 4. A candidate intending to re-appear at the Examination under these rules shall be allowed to do so without keeping fresh terms.
- 5. A candidate intending to re-appear at the Examination under these rules may appear for the examination of the papers (minimum two) either at November/December or May/June subject to Rule No.2
- 6. A candidate intending to re-appear for the Under Graduate/ Postgraduate Examination of this University under these rules shall be governed by the rules and regulations relating to the programme and syllabi which may be prescribed by the University authorities in the case of regular students' grade of this University from time to time. It is entirely the responsibility of the candidate to ascertain that the papers he/she chooses are a part of a syllabus in force and are actually taught for the said examination.
- 7. The result of the candidate appearing for the Examination under these rules will be declared only if he passes the papers for which he/she examined in a grade higher than the grade he/she possesses. The marks obtained by the candidate whose grade is not improved will be made known to him on request and on the payment of prescribed fees. So also the statement of marks/ Grade for his early year examination will be issued on payment of prescribed fees.
- 8. The answer books of the candidates appearing under this scheme can be verified and valuated as per the prevailing rules of the University. Revaluation facility is not available for the candidates appearing for the grade Improvement.



- 9. A candidate re-appearing for the examination under these rules and /or obtaining higher grade without ordinance shall not be eligible to appear again for the same examination in the same subject or subjects for securing a higher grade.
- 10. A candidate passing any of the examinations mentioned above under these rules shall not be eligible to receive any prizes, scholarships etc. instituted by the University and he/she shall also not be entitled to a merit certificate from the University.
- 11. If a candidate is unable to get a higher grade under this scheme, his/her previous performance in the corresponding examination shall remain valid.
- 12. A candidate who improves his/her grade under this scheme shall have to surrender his/her '**Degree Certificate to the University**'. In the absence of previous degree certificate of the candidate, the new Degree certificate under the 'Improvement of Grade Scheme' will not be conferred upon the candidate.
- 13. The candidate shall pay full examination fees as prescribed by the University authorities from time to time irrespective of whether the candidate opts for the subjects of Sem.-I or Sem.-II **or** both Semesters of Final year for UG programmes.

14.In case of PG programmes the candidate shall pay full examination fees as prescribed by the University authorities from time to time irrespective of whether the candidate may opt for the subjects of Sem-I or Sem-II from ME Part-I or any subject of Sem-III from ME Part-II OR any of the two semesters out of three semesters from ME part-I and ME part-II.
