THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDRESTADING (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is executed on this 15th Day Avg 2024 at Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur.

BETWEEN

Sevavardhini, **Pune**, having its office at Chandan, 26, Prasahant Nagar, Navi Peth, Pune 411 030, Maharashtra, hereinafter referred to as "**Sevavardhini**", represented by its Secretary, Shri Somadatta Ramchandra Patwardhan, age 70 years ... **Party of the First Part**;

AND

PUNYASHLOK AHILYADEVI HOLKAR SOLAPUR UNIVERSITY, SOLAPUR Established in 2004, Non-Agricultural State University, having its registered office at Kegaon, Solapur, Pune National Highway, Solapur- 413 255 hereinafter referred to as "PAHSUS" represented by Registrar (which expression shall unless the meaning or context otherwise requires shall mean and include its successors and assigns) Party of the Second Part.

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Scope:

First Party & Second Party believe that for providing a better platform for society and stake holders including students from the university campus schools, departments / center of institutions and also the students from the various affiliated colleges / institutions and also the students from the autonomous colleges / institutions etc. within the jurisdiction of this university, to give better opportunities in various fields of education and interdisciplinary research etc. the collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

1. Objectives of the MoU:

As "PAHSUS" has name of Hon. Ahilyadevi Holkar. Ahilyadevi Holkar had built so many Barav i.e. Step well for public interests. "PAHSUS" & Sevavardhini are making MoU for rejuvenation of Baravs i.e. Step wells in the state of Maharashtra in view of 300th Birth Anniversary of Hon. Ahilyadevi Holkar.

Besides this main object, both parties will work together for following objectives

- To create social awareness about Integrated rural development, Education, Adolescent education, Health, Self-employment, Water conservation and Natural resource conservation amongst men, women, youth & students from Society.
- 2. To explain to the society including men, women, youth & students the rural development related problems in the society.
- 3. To train the society including men, women, youth & students to solve climate change related problems in rural & urban area.
- 4. To disseminate information related to natural resources and climate change issue to the society including men, women, youth & students.
- 5. To clearly explain role of the society including men, women, youth & students in maintaining good health, education, natural resources, livelihood.
- To organize public awareness programs to make the society aware of the importance of natural resources management, rural development, heritage water structure viz. Barav i.e. stepwell.
- 7. To provide utmost support and training to the students practicing health camp.

3. Areas of collaboration:

- 1. To organize Shramdan for rejuvenation of Barav & old water bodies for NSS student & other students.
- To include government and non-government components in rural development, natural resource management and issues & matters regarding climate change, health, education and environment pollution.
- To work with Mahila Mandal, Yuvak Mandal, voluntary organization and women's Self Help group about entrepreneurship development and capacity building.
- 4. Undertaking health camps in collaboration with health institutions, government institutions and educational institutions.
- 5. Providing alternatives by practicing community level problems.
- To carry out activities of awareness about and importance of health, education, rural development, natural resource management and climate change etc.
- 7. To give wide publicity of water and social welfare carried out by Ahilyadevi Holkar.

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4. Proposed modes of collaboration:

- To organize programs in educational institutions jointly by "PAHSUS" & Sevavardhini on the subjects in clause 2 & 3 above.
- 2. To organize seminar, workshop, training programme for all above subjects.
- 3. To organize programs on awareness on the above subjects. These may be by way of public meetings, discussions, debate sessions, debate competitions, essay competitions, elocution competitions, etc.
- 4. To conduct survey etc. if necessary for the project.
- 5. To arrange fellowship for various research projects.

5. Terms and Conditions:

- 1. All activities shall be executed only after written consent of both the parties.
- If the any of the college/institution etc. as mentioned in Scope wants to participate
 in the activity pursuant to this MoU, separate MoU is required to be signed by
 and between the college / institution and the party of the First Part and both the
 parties shall inform about such activity to the University / Party of the Second
 Part well in advance.
- 3. This Memorandum of Understanding reflects the respective institutions' commitments to the terms and conditions mentioned in the MoU. This MoU does not confer any financial liability upon the parties to this agreement. This MoU shall remain in effect initially for Five (05) years and thereafter it can be renewed after taking review for another period as agreed by both the Parties. This MoU may be amended or terminated at any time by either Party provided that written notice of termination or amendment is given by the notifying Party to the other Party before (90) days of the date on which the termination or the amendment is intended to become effective. The commitments, made before the date of termination of MoU, shall continue to be operative.
- 4. Both parties may discuss and add additional terms & conditions if deemed necessary only after consultation with MoU cell of "PAHSUS"

6. Financing

This MoU does not confer any financial liability on any of the parties to this MoU. The activities which require financial assistance shall be decided by mutual discussions and consent of both the Parties and shall be initiated only after written agreement to that effect which includes financial contributions of all or any of kinds and specifying the sharing of surplus if any.

7. Nomination of Coordinators:

- 1. It is the responsibility of the Secretary and Project Associate on behalf of Sevavardhini to properly execute the agreement by following the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
- 2. The officers of Sevavavdhini will continue to cooperate in their work.
- 3. The agreement will be followed on behalf of Sevavardhini under the guidance of the Executive President and Secretary.

8 Arrangements for visiting officials

- Arrangements will be made for the visit of Sevavardhini officials to attend the program as per agreement.
- 2. The meeting between professors and Sevavardhini officials will be arranged as per the approved schedule.
- 3. After finalizing the date, time and place for the officials to visit the program venue, a pre-planning time table will be prepared for their visit.
- University coordinator will be nominated and informed to "PAHSUS" by Sevavardhini as point of contact.

. Sharing



9. Use of Names.

The parties hereto or any other institution or individuals shall not use name, logo or any other identity of either party for any advertise or display or banner or publicity or for any other purpose without express written permission.

10. Relationship between the Parties

It is expressly understood and agreed by Party of the First Part and Party of the Second Part that their relationship is for a limited and exclusive purpose as written above under this MoU. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party.

11. Confidentiality.

In the course of the activities under this MoU it may be necessary for the Parties to disclose Confidential Information. Unless otherwise expressly permitted in this agreement, any and all information, correspondence, financial statements, records, data or information that is competitively sensitive and not generally known to the public, including Surveys, Graphics, Formulas, Formulations, Analysis, Interpretations, Inventions, Discoveries, Improvements and Activities etc. of the disclosing Party disclosed by one Party to the other Party of this MoU, and other documents transmitted or communicated by either Party to the other Party that is marked as confidential or proprietary for the purposes of this agreement ("Confidential Information") shall be received and treated in confidence, and shall not be used by the receiving Party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed.

12. Intellectual Property Rights:

All Intellectual Property (including but not limited to trade secret, copyrights and patents, etc. if any) of either Party in existence on the effective date shall remain the property of their respective owner/party. Ownership of any and all Intellectual Property developed or created by or for a Party after the effective date as part of the delivery of the services or performance under this MoU shall be decided on case-to-case basis depending on the contribution of the Party to develop the same with a separate written agreement signed between the Parties.

13. Amendment

The present Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by the Parties through mutual consultation and consent. The amendments shall be signed by both the parties and shall be enclosed with the present Memorandum of Understanding and shall form an integral part thereof.

14. Validity & Termination

This MoU shall be valid for Five (05) years. The Memorandum of Understanding will inforce on the date of signing and shall remain in force throughout the period unless otherwise revoked or terminated.

Either of the Parties may terminate the present Memorandum of Understanding by giving the other party a written notice of ninety (90) days in advance of its decision to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding.

15. Settlement of Dispute

Any disputes between the parties arising out of the implementation or interpretation of the provisions of this Agreement and / or any dispute relating to any aspect of academic



cooperation shall be settled amicably or jointly resolve the dispute by direct negotiations between the top officials of the parties to this MoU at Solapur. In case it is not settled the same shall be referred by the parties jointly to an arbitrator and his decision will be binding on both the parties.

16 Non-Binding Nature.

Nothing in this MoU will be construed as creating a binding legal relationship between the Parties, with the exception of condition which will survive the expiry or termination of this MoU. This MoU is a broad statement of intent which sets forth the general basis upon which the Parties wish to proceed. No legal liability will arise in respect of any subject matter hereof unless a subsequent binding agreement is negotiated, approved, executed and delivered by the Parties to this MOU.

All the above contents are read over and understood by both the parties to this MoU. Hence the MoU is executed on --16- day of AMI-month 2024.
